PROJECT INFORMATION

The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) begins intersection improvements to alleviate congestion and increase traffic mobility at U.S. 98 (Back Beach Road) and State Road (S.R.) 79 in Panama City Beach in Bay County.

Planned improvements include:

- Adding new turn lanes
- Extending existing turn lanes
- Creating additional through lanes
- Modifying median access at Armstrong Circle
- Signalization improvements
- Pedestrian improvements including signal upgrades and new sidewalk
- Drainage improvements
- Milling and resurfacing
- Adding new signage and pavement markings

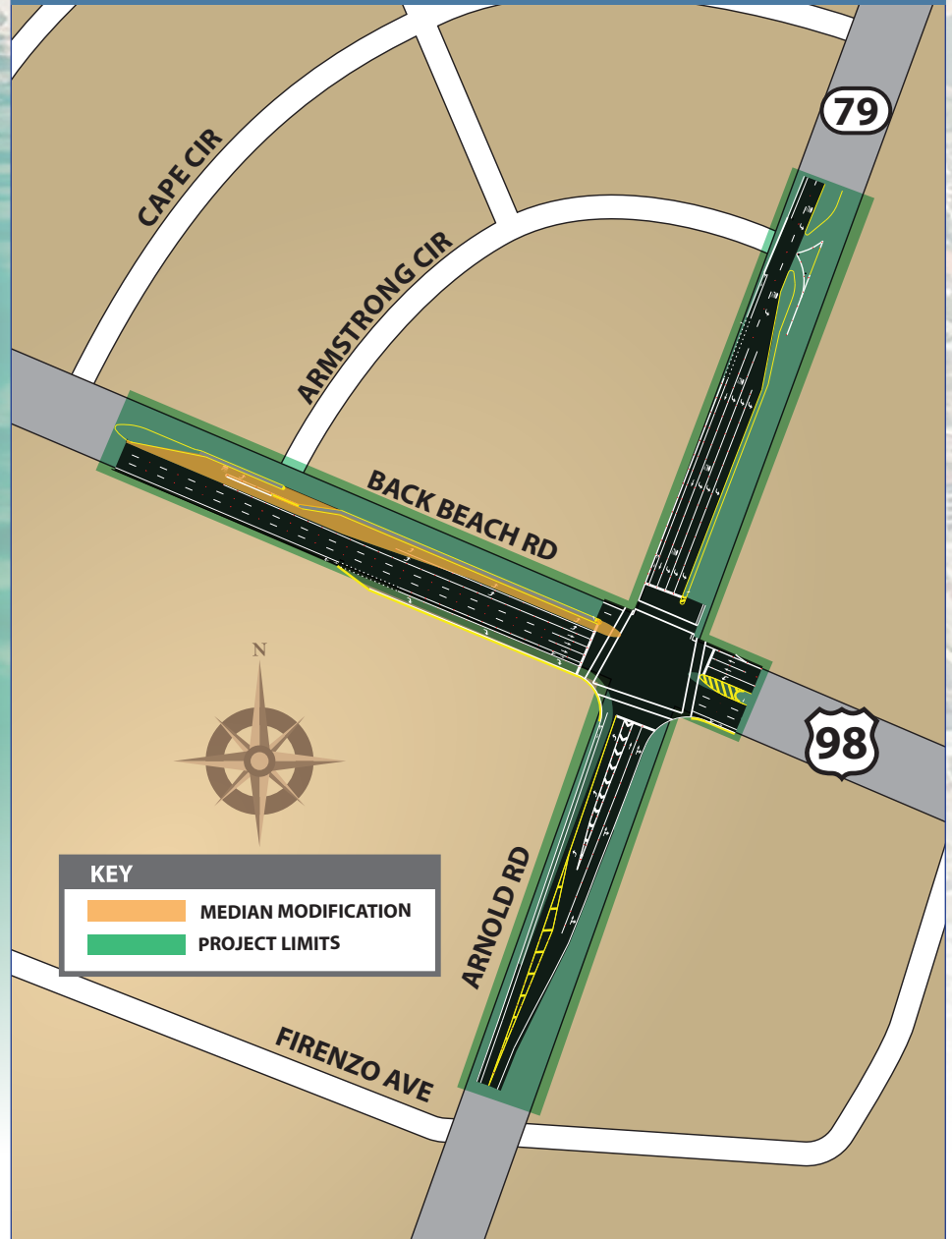
