The meeting will be held in an open  
house format beginning at 5:30 p.m.  
FDOT representatives will be available to  
discuss proposed improvements, answer

This meeting is being held to provide  
interested persons an opportunity to  
express their views concerning the  
proposed improvements.

The intent of this study is to widen I-10 from  
four to six lanes from east of the Alabama  
State line to west of State Road S.R. 95  
(U.S. 29) and reconstruct the interchanges  
at Nine Mile and Pine Forest Roads as  
Diverging Diamond Interchanges.

This study is being developed concurrently  
with a separate study for the Beulah Road  
(County Road 99) Interchange PD&E  
Study (FPID 433113-1-22-01). This  
meeting will focus on the limits from west  
of the Pensacola Weigh Station to west of  
U.S. 29.
