
FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

WHAT ARE THE STUDY LIMITS?

The proposed new roadway will provide an east-west connection between SR 267 (Bainbridge Highway) and SR 12, east of Quincy.

WHAT IS A PROJECT DEVELOPMENT AND ENVIRONMENTAL STUDY (PD&E)?

A Project Development and Environmental Study (PD&E) is a blending of preliminary engineering, environmental impact assessments, public outreach and agency coordination. In summary, it is a planning tool used to evaluate transportation improvements that are technically sound, environmentally sensitive, economically feasible and socially acceptable. A preferred alternative is selected for more detailed development.

WHAT IS THE OBJECTIVE OF THE STUDY?

The overall goal of this study is to develop a viable concept that satisfies the project purpose and need, minimizes social, economic and environmental impacts, incorporates community input, and receives approval from the Federal Highway Administration (FHWA), FDOT, and agency partners. The results of the study will determine the design configuration of the Quincy Bypass Northern Loop. The study will evaluate the “Build” and “No-Build” Alternatives based on the recommendation of the previous completed study. As part of this study, FDOT will evaluate a roundabout at the intersection with SR 12/Quincy Bypass, south of the Quincy Municipal Airport.

WHEN WILL THE PROJECT BE BUILT?

While design is fully funded, other future phases of the project – right of way (ROW) and construction – are not fully funded. However, PD&E studies of this nature typically require five to seven years to complete.
