



## ***Construction Public Meeting Florida Department of Transportation***

The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) will host a construction public information meeting, Thursday, September 8, 2016 for the upcoming multilane projects on State Road (S.R.) 10 (U.S. 90A/Nine Mile Road) from County Road 99 (Beulah Road) to S.R. 95 (U.S. 29) in Escambia County.

Work will include widening Nine Mile Road, between Beulah Road and U.S. 29, from two to four lanes; constructing a new bridge over Eleven Mile Creek; sidewalks; stormwater retention ponds; signalization improvements; and additional drainage upgrades. Construction activities along the corridor will begin September 2016 and are slated for completion in fall 2018.

FDOT personnel will be available at the meeting to provide information about planned construction work and potential impacts.
