

THE PURPOSE OF THIS PROJECT IS TO:

- Increase roadway capacity.
- Enhance multi-modal features such as bike lanes, sidewalks, and shared use paths.
- Increase roadway safety.
- Minimize environmental and social impacts created by improvements.
- Provide a connection to the St. Marks Trail.

Why is this project needed?

This project is needed to improve capacity and safety issues on S.R. 371/S.R. 373 (Orange Avenue) from S.R. 263/Capital Circle SW to S.R. 61/South Monroe Street within the City of Tallahassee.

What is a PD&E study?

A Project Development and Environment (PD&E) study is the formal process where options are developed and compared with each other to determine which best meets the projects needs while minimizing impacts to the community, natural and physical environments. This study is being developed as a Type 2 Categorical Exclusion by the FDOT following the requirements of the National Environmental Policy Act (NEPA).
